

CHAPTER 38

LIQUEFIED PETROLEUM GASES

SECTION 3801 GENERAL

3801.1 Scope. The storage, handling, and transportation of liquefied petroleum gas and the installation of all equipment pertinent to systems for such uses upstream of the outlet of the first stage regulator shall be governed by Chapter 119, Article 5 of the North Carolina General Statutes and by the North Carolina Administrative Code, Title 2, Chapter 38.

3801.2 Permits. For permits see Chapter 1.

3801.3 Inspection. It shall be the duty of the North Carolina Department of Agriculture to inspect liquefied petroleum gas installations to determine if the provisions of this chapter are being complied with.

3801.4 Installation. All liquefied petroleum gas equipment including such equipment installed at utility gas plants shall be installed in accordance with the provisions of NFPA 58 and NFPA 59, except as otherwise provided in this chapter or in laws or regulations legally in effect.



SECTION 3802 DEFINITIONS

3802.1 Definition. The following word and term shall, for the purposes of this chapter and as used elsewhere in this code, have the meaning shown herein.

LIQUEFIED PETROLEUM GAS (LP-gas). A material which is composed predominantly of the following hydrocarbons or mixtures of them: propane, propylene, butane (normal butane or isobutane) and butylenes.
