## ORDINANCE

The International Codes are designed and promul gated to be adopted by reference by or dinance. Juris dictions wish ing to adopt the 2003 International Building Code as an enforce able regulation governing structures and premises should ensure that certain factual information is included in the adopt ing or dinance at the time adoption is being considered by the appropriate governmental body. The following sample adoption or dinance ad dresses several key elements of a code adoption or dinance, including the information required for in sertion into the code text.

## SAMPLE ORDINANCE FOR ADOPTION OF THE INTERNATIONAL BUILDING CODE ORDINANCE NO.\_\_\_\_

An ordinance of the **[JURISDICTION]** adopt ing the 2003 edition of the *International Building Code*, regulating and governing the conditions and main tenance of all property, buildings and structures; by providing the standards for supplied utilities and facilities and other physical things and conditions essential to ensure that structures are safe, sanitary and fit for oc cupation and use; and the condemnation of buildings and structures unfit for human oc cupancy and use and the demolition of such structures in the **[JURISDICTION]**; providing for the is su ance of per mits and collection of fees there for; repealing Ordinance No. \_\_\_\_\_\_ of the **[JURISDICTION]** and all other or dinances and parts of the ordinances in conflict there with.

The [GOVERNING BODY] of the [JURISDICTION] does or dain as follows:

Section 1. That a cer tain doc u ment, three (3) cop ies of which are on file in the of fice of the **[TITLE OF JURISDICTION'S KEEPER OF RECORDS]** of **[NAME OF JURISDICTION]** be ing marked and des ig nated as the *International Building Code*, 2003 edition, in cluding Appendix Chapters **[FILL IN THE APPENDIX CHAPTERS BEING ADOPTED]** (see *International Building Code* Section 101.2.1, 2003 edition), as published by the International Code Council, be and is hereby adopted as the Building Code of the **[JURISDICTION]**, in the State of **[STATE NAME]** for regulating and governing the conditions and main tenance of all property, build ings and structures; by providing the stan dards for supplied util it is and facilities and other physical things and conditions essential to ensure that structures are safe, san i tary and fit for oc cup ation and use; and the condem nation of buildings and structures un fit for hu man oc cup ancy and use and the de molition of such structures as herein provided; providiing for the is su ance of per mits and collection of fees there for; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, pen al ties, conditions and terms of said Build ing Code on file in the of fice of the **[JURISDICTION]** are hereby referred to, adopted, and made a part hereof, as if fully set out in this or dinance, with the additions, in ser tions, de le tions and changes, if any, pre scribed in Sec tion 2 of his ordinance.

Section 4. That if any section, sub section, sentence, clause or phrase of this or dinance is, for any reason, held to be un constitutional, such de cision shall not affect the valid ity of the remaining portions of this or dinance. The [GOVERNING BODY] hereby declares that it would have passed this or dinance, and each section, sub section, clause or phrase thereof, ir respective of the fact that any one or more sections, sub sections, sentences, clauses and phrases be de clared un constit utional.

Section 5. That noth ing in this or dinance or in the Build ing Code hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding impending in any court, or any rights ac quired, or li a bility in curred, or any cause or cause s of action ac quired or existing, under any act or or dinance hereby repealed as cited in Section 2 of this or dinance; nor shall any just or le gal right or remedy of any char acter be lost, impaired or affected by this or dinance.

Section 6. That the [JURISDICTION'S KEEPER OF RECORDS] is hereby or dered and di rected to cause this or di nance to be published. (An ad di tional provision may be required to di rect the num ber of times the or di nance is to be pub lished and to spec ify that it is to be in a news paper in general cir cu la tion. Posting may also be required.)

Section 7. That this or dinance and the rules, regulations, provisions, requirements, or ders and matters established and adopted hereby shall take effect and be in full force and effect [TIME PERIOD] from and after the date of its final passage and adoption.
